Tournament Notes:

- PLEASE NOTE: This is a MEDAL tournament. No advice permitted except as to information on the Rules, distance or matters of public information, such as the position of hazards or the flagstick on the putting green.
- Refunds for cancellations after the sign-up deadline are at the sole discretion of the golf course. The Board will return entry fees refunded by the course.
- Please arrive at the course at least 15 minutes prior to your tee time. Check in at the pro shop to identify yourself as being with the SoCo Peppers Golf Club Tournament.
- Closest to the Hole will be on holes 3, 6, 13, 15, and 17; measured from the ball to the edge of the hole.
- Women will play from the Red tees and men will play from the White tees.
- The Rules Committee for this tournament will be Mike Kohl and Doug Ackerman. If you are on the course and are unsure of a ruling, you may play a secondary ball into the green. Just make sure you can mark the secondary ball so that you can positively identify each one. If you need a rules interpretation, please speak with these individuals AFTER you complete your round, but BEFORE you sign your card.
- All players must sign the score card. By doing so, all players are verifying that the score recorded for each hole is correct. You are **not** responsible for the mathematics resulting in your total score.
- The 10 stroke mercy rule will be in effect.
- Golf Carts are mandatory for all players.

COVID Notes and Rule Adjustments:

There are rakes in the bunkers. As we may encounter inconsistent conditions, you may smooth/level the sand for both location of the ball and your stance, and replace your ball.

I will have scorecards made up beforehand. Each group should keep their own scorecard; ideally at least 2 so they can compare after the round as usual. A player is responsible for the hole-by-hole scores, not the addition. To limit how much the scorecards are handled we will forego the usual initialing.

The bar is open, so I will be outside the bar collecting scorecards... Also free drinks if you want me to count your score...LOL.... You may also take a picture of the scorecard and email to me at callaway_golfer@comcast.net – BEFORE you leave the course. If you do email me the scorecard, remember to include any updates on the par 3's that you hit closest-to and moved the tee.
