Tournament Notes:

- 1. PLEASE NOTE: This is a MEDAL tournament. No advice permitted except as to information on the Rules, distance or matters of public information, such as the position of hazards or the flagstick on the putting green.
- 2. Women will play from the RED tees and men will play from the WHITE tees. Some seniors may play from the RED tees.
- 3. Closest to the Hole will be on all par-3 holes; measured from the ball to the edge of the hole.
- 4. The Rules Committee for this tournament will be Joe Kraynik, Mick Beeson, and Cheri Brannon. If you are on the course and are unsure of a ruling, you may play a secondary ball into the green. Just make sure you can mark the secondary ball so that you can positively identify each one. If you need a rules interpretation, please speak with these individuals AFTER you complete your round, but BEFORE you sign your card.
- 5. All players must sign the score card. By doing so, all players are verifying that the score recorded for each hole is correct. You are **not** responsible for the mathematics resulting in your total score.
- 6. The 10 stroke mercy rule will be in effect.

COVID Notes and rule adjustments:

This year we will NO LONGER be using the COVID bunker rule so play it as it lies in the bunkers. We can readdress this if we start getting complaints of being in large footprints or unkept bunkers.
